COMMON AREAS ACCESS

All roads are common areas. Ride your bike or just stroll around our beautiful 52-year-old, 35 acre park!

We have 3 bathhouses. They are located near the lake, at the Rec Center or up on the hill.

Our laundry, arcade, family room and Rec area are all common access. Shoot basketball, play pool or jump in our giant pool (largest privately owned in Sevier County). We have mini golf, ping pong, shuffleboard, basketball and more.

If you want to access the creek but are not renting beside the creek, the best access is in the field located in our Rec area. This common area continues around the bend and up to the mini golf area where Noisy Branch meets Webb Creek.

NOTE: The Corner Creek Grotto is not on OR@G property and is clearly marked at the property boundary.

The lake is accessible by common paved paths. One access is across from the lake bathhouse, and the other is on the opposite side. Guests are welcome to walk around the lake or fish. We ask that you stay on the grass path around the lake and avoid private lots without permission. Sitting in chairs to fish is best done around our two access paths.

OR@G appreciates our owners. As part of that appreciation, we are committed to keeping their property safe. Please do not go onto any lot without permission. It could be considered trespassing in some circumstances.

No speeding in the park. DO NOT EXCEED 10 MPH AT ANYTIME.

All campfires must be contained within the fire pit and extinguished before leaving them. OR@G may restrict burning under any extreme conditions as deemed necessary.
